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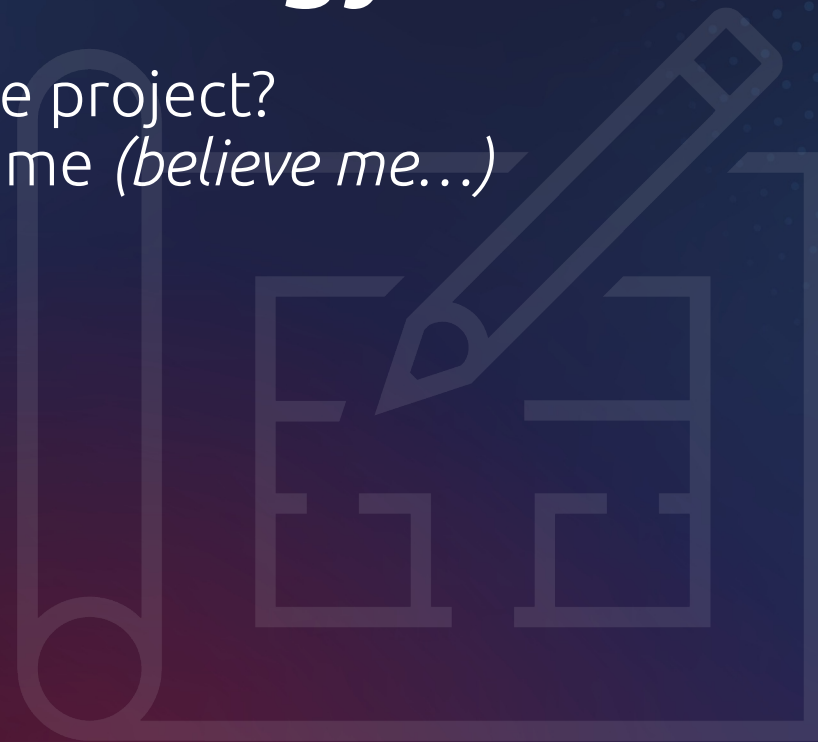

Debriefing

Build a team

Timing
Schedule enough time for testing!


Start
Do not simply run but think before you start.
Let the templates run instead!

#2 - Templating

This is where the fun begins...
But keep these Dos and Don'ts in mind!



• DO

- Try different approaches and challenge your solution permanently
- Coordinate within the team
- Take breaks and reflect on your progress
- Always question the briefing

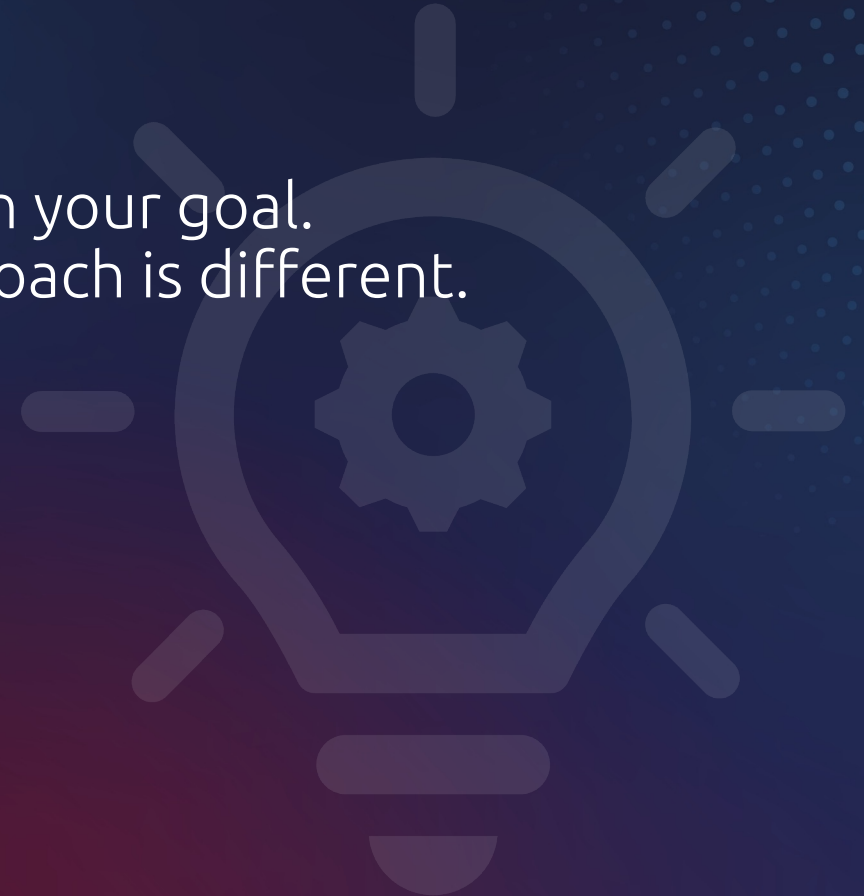
• DON'T

- Just upload everything to CHILI publisher
- Work the way you “have always done it”
- Let yourself be pressured
- Only look at the CHILI template
- Think you must manage it on your own



#3 - Example

Let's look at different ways to reach your goal.
The result will be the same, but the approach is different.



Work on the logic

- A typical task with templates is **controlling the visibility of variables and/or layers** on a user's input.
- Very **easy to implement** in the action editor
- The **more complex** the templates become, the **more lines of code** are needed
- **Too much code**
 - **reduces performance**
 - **makes it difficult to keep track of the logic**

The classic approach

15.	else if	variable	Select Variant	displayValue	=	string	Variant 3
16.	set	variable	Text_Variant_1	visible	=	false	
17.	set	variable	Text_Variant_2	visible	=	false	
18.	set	variable	Text_Variant_3	visible	=	true	
19.	set	layer	Variant 1	visible	=	false	
20.	set	layer	Variant 2	visible	=	false	
21.	set	layer	Variant 3	visible	=	true	

3

This block with 7 lines is needed for every layout variant (3 variants)
(21 lines of code in total)

How about this...?

- **Instead** of showing and **hiding all layers/variables for each possibility**, we can do this for **all of them at once** before the query starts
- Once all layers and variables are hidden, we **only** need to **show** the **required** ones
- Fixed variables don't need to be shown and hidden
 - we can just **swap** the **values between variables**

Let's do it!

4.	if	variable	Select Variant	displayValue	=	string	Variant 1

6.	set	variable	Text	value	=	variable	Text_Variant_1 value
7.	else if	variable	Select Variant	displayValue	=	string	Variant 2
8.	set	layer	Variant 2	visible	=	true	
9.	set	variable	Text	value	=	variable	Text_Variant_2 value
10.	else if	variable	Select Variant	displayValue	=	string	Variant 3
11.	set	layer	Variant 3	visible	=	true	
12.	set	variable	Text	value	=	variable	Text_Variant_3 value

This action does the same in only 12 lines of code - saved us almost 50%!
